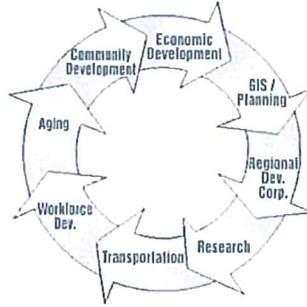

The COG Board approved the action to flex \$40,000 of our guideshare dollar allocation to our regional public transportation agency – Santee Wateree Regional Transportation Authority.

The approved motion / action is to Flex \$40,000 of the SCDOT Santee-Lynches Regional Council of Governments Guideshare Funds to Santee Wateree Regional Transportation Authority. The Santee Wateree Regional Transportation Authority will discretionally use these funds within their budget to help sustain the SmartRide commuter bus service from Camden to Columbia for FY 2009 - 2010. The "flex" of \$40,000 to Santee Wateree Regional Transportation Authority will be effective 1 July 2009.
