RFP Questions and Responses**

1. Is there space available at the SC Works offices in Clarendon, Kershaw, Lee and Sumter counties to hold program activities?

There is space available by reservation at most of the facilities in the region for activities such as workshops, testing, orientation sessions, soft skills training, etc. Arrangements would need to be made at the sites in advance of use.

2. Will SCWOS be used for case management and to capture WIOA milestones? If so, can training be provided to staff unfamiliar with the data management system and update experienced staff on any changes with the system?

SC Works Online Services (SCWOS) is the current reporting system used for case management and capturing WIOA milestones. Training is always provided to staff unfamiliar with the data management system and staff are updated regularly on any changes or updates to system.

3. As a company that assists individuals with job searches and businesses with recruitment, would it be considered a conflict of interest to continue to assist South Carolina residents who are not eligible for program participation with finding jobs, while being privy to employment opportunities through connections made as a service provider for the Santee-Lynches RCOG program?

WIOA funds can only be used to serve individuals determined eligible for the WIOA program. Individuals not eligible for program participation should be referred to one of our partner agencies (for example: Wagner-Peyser Services provided by the SC Department of Employment and Workforce (SCDEW), etc.) for services. SCDEW is also one of our partners, along with other business services staff, who provides services to businesses.
